“A Brotherhood Fallen”

Dear San Andreas,

On February 21st, 2023 at approximately 9:00p.m, the United States Marshal Service and Major Crimes Division, with invaluable assistance from LSPD, BCSO, and SASP, conducted two raids on a criminal organization known as “The Brotherhood”. No hostages or law enforcement were significantly injured during the raid, and all suspects were apprehended. The first raid took place at La Linterna where a large assortment of illegal items were found and seized. This included, but not limited to, Class 1 and Class 2 drugs and paraphernalia, and illegally circulated currency used in the trafficking of aforementioned drugs. The second conducted resulted in a large number of Class 1 and Class 2 firearms, as well as more drug paraphernalia, US Currency used in the trafficking of said paraphernalia, and more Class 2 drugs.

The total street value of the two conducted raids was estimated at approximately:

\$1,345,087

As well as, 25 vehicles seized and 2 businesses shut down.

Words cannot fully express the feeling of pride and respect the United States Marshal Service has for the Detectives, Law Enforcement Officers, Deputy Marshals, and Department of Justice prosecutors that worked diligently throughout the two situations. It can be said with certainty that San Andreas is in fact a safer place after these successful raids. This is just the beginning for joint operations between the United States Marshal Service, Major Crimes Division, and San Andreas Law Enforcement. We are committed to this group effort to bring more criminal organizations to justice, and face the legal system for the crimes they have committed.

We wish the best for the citizens of San Andreas, and hope they can be reassured knowing that significant efforts will be made, and continued to be made by Law Enforcement to do justice for those who were wronged.
