I appreciate your support throughout the campaign trail. While the video was great, it didn't fully capture the specific ideas I intend to implement if elected as State Representative. The following are some ideas I'd like to work on, but please note that they are open to revision. I plan to engage with all relevant stakeholders to shape these ideas into well-rounded legislation. After all, it's not about what I want but about what YOU want and what's best for the state.

1. I'd like to propose modifications to the [Freedom of Information Act of 2022](#). Specifically, I aim to enable the public to access the personal criminal records of Government Officials within the Executive and Legislative Branches without undue denial. I'd also like to make amendments to section ten, Denied Request, to elaborate on exactly what merits a denial.

FOIA can be a frustrating process. So, I'd simply like to approve and clarify aspects of the bill. It doesn't have to be a difficult process. It's a fundamental democratic right - the government works for **you**, and **you** have a right to know what they're up to. If you have a government **OF** the people and **FOR** the people, you should be **accountable** to the people.

2. I'd like to introduce lethal injection as a second choice to those facing capital punishment. (Execution by firing squad will not be altered.) How a lethal injection will be conducted and how the injection itself will be created, will face heavy altering to address concerns made by San Andreas Medical Services (SAMS) and individuals alike.

**"B-but they deserve it! They were evil!"** I understand. People will want the individual who ruined their lives and took the lives of those they love to suffer, but the moment we give the government power to dehumanize the worst of us, the easier it will be for them to dehumanize all of us.

3. I want to create a new governmental department called the **San Andreas Rescue Service (SARS)**. It will be similar to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and focus solely on creating public and government action plans in the case of statewide disasters. I would also like it to provide disaster relief to businesses affected by these catastrophes.
4. Lastly, I'd like to further utilize the Public Safety Alerts made by SAMS and Law Enforcement Officers (LEOs). Public safety concerns - not simply roadblocks and hospital lockdowns - should be available to the public. This legislation may include incidents such as prison breaks and large-scale terrorist attacks.
