Statement In Regards to the Daily Globe

Paleto Bay, San Andreas -- On August 29th, 2023, the news company known as the Daily Globe published an article titled: "Richard Starr's Dossier is Made Public - Criminal Allegations Against Becks Lawson and Jacob Wheeler". This article contained a large number of serious allegations against two public figures, both of whom are running for elected office as we speak.
